AmigaWorld.net roots date back to 1999 when David Doyle and a small group of like minded Amigans formed #Amigaworld, an IRC Channel on Undernet. Their aim was to create the most friendly and helpful Amiga channel on the Internet. In 2000 they launched an associated website to profile their IRC channel and so AmigaWorld.net was born. According to David, "I formed Amigaworld.net for several reasons, first and foremost a friendly place where the Amiga community can communicate without being flamed, second my love of Amigas, and third my love of web site development."



Over the years AmigaWorld popularity grew and the site evolved into it's present format. A sponsorship deal was secured with Kicksoft and this was followed by major deal with Eyetechnology, when AmigaWorld.net was appointed the official website for posting AmigaONE forums and news. Since that time it has become a focal point for news about AmigaOS 4 and other next-generation Amiga-inspired systems. In recent times David has had less time to devote to his AmigaWorld creation and, in his own words, "was looking for a safe pair of hands to ensure its future". He looked no further than A-EON co-founder Trevor Dickinson. On the transfer to A-EON Technology David commented, "What a ride its been since founding the site over 14 years ago. I have lots of fond memories such as the Amigaworld.net team trip to AmiGBG 2004 Sweden, the Q&A sessions with Amiga, Inc. CTO Fleecy Moss on Amigaworld's IRC channel. But now it is time for me to move on with new projects. So I couldn't think of better new owner than a company owned and run by Amiga enthusiasts, A-EON



Technology Ltd, to hand the site over to. I know that the site will be in good hands and will have a long future." In response, A-EON co-founder, Trevor Dickinson added, "I have been an active supporter and poster on AmigaWorld since late 2004. I've always had a soft spot for AmigaWord. It was the first Amiga forum I signed up to and it was always my first port of call for all my next-generation Amiga news."
